Officials of the National Merit Scholarship Corporation announced the names of approximately 16,000 students throughout the country as Semifinalists in the 68th annual National Merit Scholarship Program. The nationwide pool of Semifinalists represents less than one percent of U.S. high school seniors and includes the highest scoring entrants in each state, explains the NMSC.
