#### Class Time

3:20pm to 4:20pm

Note: At 3:00pm children will be escorted to the cafeteria to eat a snack brought from home prior to their class. A monitor will supervise.

#### Class Size

Class sizes are limited to ensure a quality program.

There are also a minimum number of children required to run the classes (the minimum is noted in the description of each class). If the minimum requirement is not met, WPESA has the right to cancel the class.

#### Class Confirmation

Registration forms will be dated upon submission and given priority on that basis. If there is insufficient registration for a course, it will be cancelled. Class confirmation will be sent home with your child a week before the after-school program begins

#### Class Fee

Fees vary per class and days. Payment should be made for the 1<sup>st</sup> class chosen. If your first choice is not available, you will be notified on your confirmation letter as to any balance due. Please make all checks payable to WPESA.

#### Financial Assistance

Financial Aid may be available for some classes. Please call Mrs. Brewster at 666-2190 to determine eligibility.

#### Changes / Refunds

No changes or refunds are allowed upon receipt of registration unless a class is cancelled. The registration fee will not be pro-rated for late registrants.

#### Class Cancellations

If class is cancelled due to weather or illness of the instructor, you will be contacted at the phone numbers listed and/or e-mail address on the registration form. Every effort will be made to reschedule cancelled classes.

#### Absences

All students registered for an after-school class will be removed from the bus lines rather than risk being sent home to an empty house. If your child is in school and won't be staying for an after-school class, a note must be sent to their teacher. Any change in pick-up from that stated on the registration form must be submitted in writing.

#### Volunteer Shifts

In an effort to keep the cost of the after-school program down, we ask parents and/or guardians to consider volunteering their time to help perform certain tasks. The success of the after-school program depends upon the generosity of our volunteers. Volunteers are needed for the following tasks:

**Monitors :** Monday – Thursday 3:00pm to 4:30pm

Monitors check children into the after-school program, remain in the building while the classes are in session to help instructors in the event of an emergency, and dismiss children to their parents or guardians when classes end. Monitors are entitled to one (1) class discount of 50% for a WPES student.

#### Pick-Up Procedure

**Upon completion of class, a WPESA representative will dismiss the children from the GYM entrance. Please do not depart from the school without signing your child out.** Pick-up must be promptly at 4:20pm. Children will ONLY be release to authorized person(s) indicated on this form or when a signed note is submitted. If a child is not picked up by 4:30pm, and no contact is made with parent(s)/contact(s) on this form, the Bedford Police will be contacted. After the 3<sup>rd</sup> late pick-up, your child will be dismissed from the class for the session without reimbursement.

#### Student Behavior

In order to ensure everyone's safety and enjoyment of the classes, it is expected that children will follow direction, work cooperatively with others and respect the rights, feelings and properties of others. If your child is having difficulty behaving appropriately, you will be contacted. In some situations and for some classes, the child may be removed from the class. No refunds will be given. Please carefully consider your choices for your child's after-school activity to assure your child's fulfillment and enjoyment.
