Projects will range from making tote bags to using clothing patterns (depending on abilities and interest). Students will learn the process from beginning to end of pinning fabric, measuring and cutting patterns, to finishing work on a project or garment.</p> <p>Students will have the opportunity to block print their own fabric for their project.</p> <p>Club members will visit the High School to see students work in the fashion department.</p> <p>During the sewing process students will be assisted by the High School fashion students to guide them through the process. Club dates enable students to apply their sewing skills to the FLMS production which begins in January and opens mid March.</p> <p>Maximum 18 students.</p>
